## System Generated XML Testing Instructions

Volume VII of the COD Technical Reference is intended for schools and software providers to to validate XML schema using COD system generated responses files.

The examples included in the subsequent sections are intended to validate that a system can successfully import COD system generated XML files. They are not intended to validate any business rule processing.

Users intending to validate the schema may have to modify the content of the examples, depending on the software provider. For example, you may have to modify the <OPEID> value in order to import the sample COD system generated XML response file. Specific changes may vary by software provider.
